## What's New?

Amateur Youth Bowlers Tour (AYBT) had an outstanding year for the 2020-21 season! In just the first year of the tour, AYBT brought 230 total bowlers, and awarded \$24,000 in scholarship! The AYBT is committed and excited to begin a bigger and better season for the 2021-22 season! We are widely expanding the tour and excited to be bringing one event into the state of Wisconsin. We are also expanding our formats! Instead of the same format for all events, we are hosting one Adult/Youth event, one Doubles, and two events with our new Major format! We have also bumped our eligibility age up from 21 to 23!

## Formats

**AYBT Normal Events-** A normal event on the AYBT consists of 6 qualifying games, following the qualifying the top 25% will be cut to bowl 2 Advancer's Round games followed by a cut to the Top 6, where the 1st seed receives a bye into the final match and the 2nd seed receives a bye into the semi-finals match. 3rd vs. 6th, 4th vs. 5th. Winners will bowl a match against each other, winner of the match will bowl 2nd seed, winner will bowl 1st seed for the championship.

**Major-** Majors will be a brand new format being introduced to the AYBT in the 2021-22 season. Majors will be the most grinding events on the AYBT, and with that, the most rewarding in terms of scholarships, points, and meaning. Majors will be 3-day events, with three 5-game qualifying blocks (Morning Day 2 squad, Afternoon Day 2 squad, Morning Day 3 squad) on three different patterns. Day 1 will be the practice session on the tournament's patterns. After all qualifying blocks, the field will be cut to the top 50% to bowl 2 more games, followed by a cut to the Top 8 into a PBA Playoffs style bracket match play. Refer to Chapter 2 Rule #2.b.ii of the AYBT Rules for more information on PBA Playoffs style match play.

**Adult/Youth-** 3 individual games and 6 baker games of qualifying, cut based on entries. Following the cut, double elimination match play in Baker format will be performed to determine the winners. U12, U15, and U18 divisions will be offered.

**Doubles-** 6 individual games of qualifying, cut depending on entries. double elimination match play performed in Baker format with 2 game total pinfall matches will determine the winner.

**Finale-** Please refer to Chapter 2 Rule #1e of AYBT rules for Finale format.
